Beloved of Hebron,

When Methodist pastors are ordained, we are asked a series of questions that go all the way back to the days of John Wesley. Standing before all the pastors in the Annual Conference, the bishop asks those about to be ordained about our faith in Christ, our belief in the Holy Scriptures, and our commitment to the United Methodist Church. There are 19 questions in all, and during my first month at Hebron, I've been thinking a lot about #15: "Will you visit from house to house?"

Thanks to your hospitality, I can answer honestly that yes, I have visited from house to house! I am grateful to God for the way that y'all have welcomed me to front porches and back patios, put on your masks and kept safe distance, and greeted me warmly, even during a pandemic.

My goal is to visit with every family in the Hebron community by Christmas, although the coronavirus means it might take me a little longer. If I've already visited with you: thanks again for having me! And if I haven't visited with you yet: never fear, I'll be contacting you soon!

As I continue my visits in the months ahead, I wanted to let you know the reasons that I'm inviting myself over to your house! The first is this: these visits give me a chance to get to know each person or family at Hebron, and they give you a chance to get to know me. And the second, even more important reason I begin each new appointment by making these kinds of visits is this: I need to listen. God has been at work at Hebron long before I got here and will still be at work in this community long after I'm appointed somewhere else. My goal is always to join the work that God is already doing, and to support this community in doing the work that God has called Hebron to do.

With that in mind, I ask two questions as I visit from house to house:

When have you seen Hebron at its best? What gifts has God given to this particular church?

How can we use those gifts as God leads us into the future?

As I listen to your stories, I take a few notes, and after I've completed all my visits, I'll look back over everything I've heard, and find some common themes. Then, your church leadership team will take some time apart digest your stories, listen for God's guidance, and plan for the next season of life at Hebron. I'll keep you updated as my visits continue, and ask that you keep listening for God's voice as you reflect on the gifts God has given to Hebron, and how we can use those gifts as God leads us into the future. And please keep the ideas and stories coming!

I am deeply grateful for the chance to visit with y'all as I go from house to house, and for the chance to be part of what God is doing at Hebron in this season!
